We praise You at this time of the blessing of this house, and at all festivals and times, and seasons and hours, and during all the days of our lives for ever and ever.

SEDRA

Priest: O Lord, You are the refuge of those who trust in You, and who call upon You with broken hearts; You are the strong and high fortress for those who are tormented by enemies - visible and invisible, and those who are heavy-laden with powerful temptations. You are the ocean of kindness and mercy who desires for the life and salvation of man. Our Lord and our God, in Your mercy, hearken unto us and accept our prayers and supplications which we offer in Your glorious presence, along with this incense, on behalf of this house and its dwellers. Lord, gladden their hearts and

make this house rich with all good things and blessings. Save this household from all kinds of evil and sorrows. May all the dealings in this house be for the glory of Your Name. Merciful Lord, mark this house with the sign of Your adorable Cross. Protect those who live in this house, just as the houses of the children of Israel were sprinkled with the Passover blood and they were saved from the angel who smote all the first born of Egypt. By the sign of thread that was tied to the window of Rahab, her entire household was spared and saved. In the same manner, spare and save this house and its dwellers from the evil one and his hosts, by the sign of the Holy Cross that is being made on it. Even as Satan was ashamed and fled from Job the just, may Satan be ashamed and flee from this house.

Lord, just as You entered into the house of Zachaeus, the publican and blessed him, enter into this house and bless it as well as those who dwell in it. Bless this house, its dwellers, their earnings and all their belongings, just as you shed your mercy and blessing on Cornelius and his household and saved them. Give them blessed offsprings who adore Your Holy Name and gladden their parents. Remove from them heavy punishments, famine, epidemics and all forms of difficulties. Assign the angel of peace on this house and its dwellers. Save them from the envy of the devils, from unjust authorities, and the designs of evil men by Thy Victorious Cross, which is the high fortress of the faithful. Increase their belongings thirty, sixty, and hundred fold. Enable us to please Thy will by just and pure activities. Console and have mercy upon our departed ones, and all the faithful departed.

Unto Thee we ascribe praise and thanksgiving, to Thee and to Thine only begotten Son, and to Thy Holy Spirit, forever and ever.

He wanted to see who Jesus was, but being a short man he could not, because of the crowd. So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree to see him, since Jesus was coming that way. When Jesus reached the spot, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, come down immediately. I must stay at your house today." So he came down at once and welcomed him gladly. All the people saw this and began to mutter, "He has gone to be the guest of a 'sinner.'" But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord! Here and now, I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount." Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham. For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost."
